Personal Clothing and Equipment

Holdall / suitcase / suitable bag – the children will have to transfer this a short distance, so wheels are useful!		
Waterproof jacket with a hood

Wellingtons in a named carrier bag		
Pair of sensible walking shoes or strong trainers		
Slippers or clean light shoes for indoors		
Socks and underwear, including spares		
T-shirts, sweatshirts, jumpers		
Tracksuits, jeans, trousers		
Shorts – we will be walking in woodland, so long trousers are still essential at times		
Pyjamas		
Towel, toiletries (shower gel/soap, toothbrush, toothpaste)		
Shower cap for children with long hair		
Small soft toy		
A cap with a peak and a warm hat		
Warm gloves		
Pencil case – including pencils, colouring pencils, rubbers and ruler		
A strong plastic carrier bag for dirty washing		
A rucksack – large enough to carry a clipboard, lunch box and water bottle for daytime activities		
Camera (disposable is <u>more</u> suitable, otherwise digital that the child knows how to use)		
Tuppaware style lunch box – lid <u>and</u> box named! Please do not send fabric style lunch boxes.		
Plastic drink bottle		
Game, puzzle book, reading book for the coach journey and free time
