



What is happening in Year 5 for the next two weeks?

MATHS:

We will be continuing our place value units by ordering and comparing large numbers. We will then look at rounding numbers. Finally, we will look at Roman Numerals and how to read and write them.

English:

Now that we have finished writing our speeches, we will be performing them to the class practising our oral skills. We will then begin our next unit: narrative poetry looking at and studying 'The Walrus and the Carpenter' by Lewis Carroll

OTHER SUBJECTS:

Language Week: Next week, we will be celebrating languages across the world. We will be completing fact files on lots of different languages, learning a language song, practising our numbers in French and lots more.

Art: As it is Language Week, we will be looking at famous French artists and creating our own art based on their work. The challenge: we can only use colours in the French flag so we will be also practising mixology.

History: The children will recap chronology, looking at important moments in history. We will then look at where the Anglo Saxons and Vikings appear on the timeline.

Music: The children are learning how to listen and appraise music. Therefore, we will be studying Mamma Mia by Abba. The children may even sing some of the famous lyrics in the same style.
